MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS Memorandum of Understanding is between

State Islamic Institute of Tulungagung, Indonesia (IAIN Tulungagung), located in Jl. Mayor Sujadi Timur No 46 Tulungagung

AND

Jusoh University, Pendidikan Sultan Idris of Malaysia (JU-PSI), located in Malaysia.

IAIN Tulungagung and JU-PSI may use the following protocols to govern their collaboration on academic and research-related activities.

I. Scope

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) includes the following categories:

1. Faculty/student exchange;
2. Collaborative research and projects;
3. Joint workshops, short courses and conferences;
4. Joint publications;
5. Library development.

II. Implementation

To implement this MoU, the following is mutually understood:

1. Proposals for collaborative work under this MoU will be submitted for approval through the normal procedures of each party;
2. Individual collaborative activities developed under this MoU will be the subject of separate agreements in writing;
3. The final approval of any activities will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds;

4. Each party is liable for its own acts and omissions under this MoU including for the prevention of doubt, any liability to a third party arising from its acts or omissions.

III. Non-Binding

This MoU is not intended by the parties to be legally binding and nothing in this MoU prevents either party from entering into collaborative arrangements with other organizations covering the same subject matter.

IV. Commencement, Renewal, Termination and Amendment

1. This MoU is effective as of the date of signing by the appropriate officer of the last party to sign;
2. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of four (4) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated earlier by either party giving at least six months notice to the other party in writing;
3. The MoU may be amended or extended by mutual consent in writing of the two parties;
4. If this MoU were translated into another language, both texts would be authentic but the English text would prevail in the event of a dispute.

V. Counterparts and Electronic Communications

This MoU may be executed in counterparts, which taken together will constitute one document. Counterparts may be exchanged by digital scan which may be relied upon by the receiving party as having the same legal force and effect as the original signed counterpart.
